The leader will dip a thumb in the ashes and make a cross on the forehead of each person saying, "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return" or "Repent, and believe the gospel."

CONFESSION—Psalm 51

Words below (read responsively)

Have mercy on me, O God,
according to your steadfast love;
**according to your abundant mercy
blot out my transgressions.**

Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity,
and cleanse me from my sin

**For I know my transgressions,
and my sin is ever before me.**

Against you, you only, have I sinned,
and done that which is evil in your sight,
so that you are justified in your sentence
and blameless in your judgment.

**Behold, I was born into iniquity,
and I have been sinful since my mother conceived me.**

Behold, you desire truth in the inward being;
therefore teach me wisdom in my secret heart.

**Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean;
wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow;**

Make me hear with joy and gladness;
let the bones which you have broken rejoice.

**Hide your face from my sins,
and blot out all my iniquities.**
