This program is designed to create trained discipleship coaches who can help congregations recapture a spirit of accountable discipleship and effectively develop intentional discipleship systems and pathways.

A group from my church attended a training. Is that all?

If you have attended a Recommended Best Practices training, now it is time to create a team at your church to make your own policy based on those recommendations. Then you will need to train all of your workers and volunteers to your policy.

When do we need a policy?

Our goal is to have every church have a completed, up-to-date (approved within the last 5 years) policy on file with your District Office **by October 31.**
